SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is carried. The bill is advanced. Is Senator Hoagland here? 741.

SENATOR HOAGLAND: Mr. Speaker and colleagues.

SPEAKER MARVEL: If you have an amendment, we are going to have to pass over the bill?

SENATOR HOAGLAND: I do have an amendment, Mr. Speaker. It is a real quick one.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Sorry.

SENATOR HOAGLAND: Can we pull the amendment off and we will put it on Select File, Mr. Speaker?

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 741 was introduced by Senator Hoagland. Title read. The bill was read on January 14. It was referred to Judiciary, advanced to General File. There are no amendments pending, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Hoagland.

SENATOR HOAGLAND: Mr. Speaker and colleagues, this is just a small bill. It repeals obsolete statutes such as LB 518 and the Ground Water Management Act. Beyond that, it really is not particularly significant. In addition to those two bills, it repeals the authority of a mayor to conscript eighteen to fifty year olds into a posse. It repeals a World War II provision awarding \$10,000 to anybody who can use agricultural products to come up with synthetic rubber and it repeals a number of other provisions which are outlined in a letter that has been distributed to all of you. If any of you have any questions, I'd be pleased to attempt to answer them. Thank you, Mr. Speaker.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Newell, do you wish to be recognized on the bill?

SENATOR NEWELL: Yes, we will talk about it on Select. Very good, Shirley.
