LB 674, 649

CLERK: Madam Chair, LB 674 was introduced by the Speaker at the request of the Governor. (Read title.) The bill was read on January 10. It was referred to Appropriation. The bill was advanced to General File. I have no amendments.

SENATOR MARSH: Senator Marvel.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Move the advancement of the bill to E & R for review. As the Clerk has indicated this is the payment of salaries of constitutional officers for the period July 1st 1980, to June 30, 1981. I renew the motion to advance the bill.

SENATOR MARSH: Senator Reutzel.

SENATOR REUTZEL: A question of Senator Marvel.

SENATOR MARSH: Senator Marvel, will you yield?

SPEAKER MARVEL: Yes, sir.

SENATOR REUTZEL: Does this include judges? It doesn't?

SPEAKER MARVEL: I will read you who is covered in just a moment.

SENATOR REUTZEL: Senator Marvel, I have been informed that it does. Thank you.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The Supreme Court and the State Library salaries, clerk, reporter, forty-nine judges, yes, sir, it includes all the judges.

SENATOR MARSH: Thank you. We are now ready and will vote on the advancement of LB 674. Senator Marsh voting aye.

CLERK: Senator Marsh voting aye.

SENATOR MARSH: The Clerk will record.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 1 nay on the motion to advance the bill.

SENATOR MARSH: The bill is advanced. We will pass over the next three bills. We are ready for 649.

CLERK: Madam Chair, LB 649 was introduced by Senator Don Wagner. (Read title.) The bill was read on January 9, referred to Public Works. It was advanced to General File. I have committee amendments by Senator Kremer's Public Works Committee.
