SPEAKER MARVEL: Do you want to move the advancement of the bill?

SENATOR VICKERS: Let's get the committee amendments on first.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, committee amendments first. All those in favor of the adoption of the committee amendments to 908 vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? We are voting on the committee amendments to 908. Record.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays on adoption of committee amendments.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, the committee amendments are adopted. Now, Senator Vickers, do you want to advance the bill? Do you want to advance the bill as amended?

SENATOR VICKERS: Yes, Mr. Speaker, I move we advance 908 as amended.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is to advance 908 as amended to E & R for review. All those in favor vote aye, opposed no. Have you all voted? I think after this vote we will adjourn. I was in hopes that we would get the other three but... Pardon? Okay, if you will stay in your seats for just a few minutes we will try. Okay, record the vote. We are going to pass over 872. In case anybody is interested that is the bill to reduce the salary of judges.

CLERK: 28 ayes, 0 nays on the motion to advance.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is carried and the bill is advanced. Do you want to read 924?

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 924 was introduced by the Government Committee and signed by its members. (Read title.) The bill was read on January 23, referred to the Government Committee. It was advanced to General File. There are committee amendments by the Government Committee.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Merz, do you want to take the committee amendments?

SENATOR MERZ: Mr. President and members, all this amendment does is includes counties of one hundred thousand population and over. It is very simple.
