jurisdiction in time share ownership situations, to provide for the registration of the time share projects and it eliminates the possibility of fraud. It protects the public as well as the time share industry. The bill has been approved by the time share industry as well as the Nebraska Real Estate Commission and the act is being adopted or entered into other state legislatures. Hopefully this will become law in all of the states of the Union. I would certainly urge the adoption of 945 as amended.
