LB 814, 833

CLERK: 20 ayes, 23 nays on the motion to return the bill, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: 20 to 23....motion lost. We are ready....

CLERK: Yes, sir.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Before we read LB 814, in the north balcony from Senator Carsten's District, 65 seniors from Syracuse Senior High School, Syracuse, Nebraska, and their Government Instructor, Mr. George Fannon. Will you hold up your hands so we can say, good morning to you? Okay. From Senator Vickers' District there were 19 high school seniors from Orleans High School, Orleans, Nebraska, accompanied by two County Supervisors, Mr. Schoenberg and Mr. Bachus. Are you still up in the balcony? Okay. We welcome you. Now the Clerk will read on Final Reading LB 814.

CLERK: (Read LB 814 on Final Reading.)

SENATOR CLARK PRESIDING

SENATOR CLARK: All provisions of law having been complied with, the question is, shall the bill pass? All those in favor vote aye. All those opposed nay.

SPEAKER MARVEL PRESIDING

SPEAKER MARVEL: Have you all voted? Clerk, record the vote.

CLERK: (Read record vote as found on page 1075 of the Legislative Journal.) 42 ayes, 0 nays, 4 excused and not voting, 3 present and not voting, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The bill is declared passed on Final Reading. The next bill, LB 833.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read LB 833 on Final Reading.)

SPEAKER MARVEL: All provisions of law having been complied with, the question is, shall the bill pass? All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Record the vote.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read record vote as found on page 1076 of the Legislative Journal.) The vote is 34 ayes, 8 nays, 4 excused and not voting, 3 present and not voting, Mr. President.
