SPEAKER MARVEL PRESIDING

SPEAKER MARVEL: Record, round two.

CLERK: Quorum present, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Do you have some items on the desk?

CLERK: Mr. President, very quickly, Senator Haberman offers explanation of vote. (See page 1089 of the Journal.)

SPEAKER MARVEL: We are ready for item #7 which is Special Order, Select File and the first item of business is LB 276.

CLERK: Mr. President, I have a series of amendments on LB 276. The first order of business, however, is the E & R amendments.

SPEAKER MARVEL: To 276?

CLERK: 276, yes, sir, E & R amendments.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Wesely, do you want to move the E & R amendments to 276, please?

SENATOR WESELY: Mr. Speaker, I move the E & R amendments to LB 276.

SPEAKER MARVEL: All in favor of the adoption of the E & R amendments to 276 say aye, opposed no. The motion is carried. The E & R amendments are adopted.

CLERK: Mr. President, the next amendment I have is by Senator Goodrich. I understand Senator Goodrich wishes to withdraw this amendment, Mr. President.

SENATOR GOODRICH: Yes, Mr. President, members of the body, I wish to withdraw that amendment from 276 and we are going to mark it at the head there for 279. It pertains to 279 instead of 276. I wish to withdraw the amendment.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The request is the withdrawal of the Goodrich amendment to LB 276. Hearing no objection, so ordered. What is the next...?
