SPEAKER MARVEL: We have four absent. How many are absent now? Okay, four absent.

SENATOR WESELY: If I could just get four more votes we wouldn't have to have a Call of the House. More cooperation from my good friends.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Record.

CLERK: 25 ayes, no nays on a motion to adopt, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Motion is carried, the amendment is adopted.

CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Do you want to move the bill, Senator DeCamp?

SENATOR DeCAMP: Mr. President, as incredible as it sounds, no. It was my understanding that that last amendment, from the information that I had received from Bob Crosby or somebody didn't have any problems. I understand that the amendment may destroy the whole cash basis of CD's and everything else. I would like to take up the other bill and let this puppy sit awhile, which it has now become apparently. Let it sit for 15-20 minutes until I find out what Senator Wesely's amendment did, or could do, if that is acceptable. Just take up 279 and I'd hate to start over again, whereas if that amendment did have problems, I think that Senator Wesely would want to be the first to correct it. Is that okay?

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Fowler.

SENATOR FOWLER: Mr. President, I would object to fifteen minutes. If Senator DeCamp wants to lay it over a day so that all of us have a chance, I know that he can find things out in 15 minutes that would take us at least 24 hours. So if he wants to just pass over it for a day that would be fine with me. I think that 15 minutes is a bit too much.

SENATOR DeCAMP: If we lay it over for a day the earliest it could be passed as I understand it, would be Monday of next week and I was hoping we could do it Thursday of this week and I know that sounds only like three or four or five days but I assure you fellows, three or four or five days at this point in time is rather critical. So I will move to advance the bill at this time then as we were originally scheduled to do and figure out the next tactic from that point. Move the bill be advanced.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is the advancement of 276 to E & R for review. All those in favor vote aye, opposed no. Have you all voted? Record the vote.

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
