SENATOR KAHLE: We have been trying to get out to the alcohol plant south of Lincoln here. We have been invited and a group of us are going out immediately after the session today. If you are interested in going meet outside in the hall here right after we adjourn. Thank you.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, thank you. Senator Vickers.
