PRESIDENT LUEDTKE PRESIDING

CHAPLAIN: Prayer offered.

Your committee on Enrollment and Review respectfully reports we have carefully examined LB 600 and find the same correctly enrolled; 604 correctly enrolled; 681, 772, 802, 814, 833, 876, 902, 932, 981 all correctly enrolled.
