LB 280, 823, 346

PRESIDENT: Any objection to passing over it? All right, those two will be passed over by unanimous consent. We will go then to the next, LB 823.

CLERK: Mr. President, I have a series of amendments to 823. However, I have a unanimous consent request of Senator Hoagland to pass the bill over.

PRESIDENT: Any objection to that? That is 823. We had better take up something pretty soon. Hearing none, no objection, 823 is passed over. We will then be ready for, I hope, LB 346.

CLERK: Mr. President, there are E & R amendments to LB 346.

PRESIDENT: The Chair recognizes Senator Wesely. Senator Murphy, do you just want to move the E & R amendments and then we will just...on LB 346?

SENATOR MURPHY: Yes, Mr. President, I would move the adoption of the E & R amendments.

PRESIDENT: Motion to adopt the E & R amendments on LB 346. Any discussion? All those in favor of adopting the E & R amendments to LB 346 signify by saying aye, opposed nay. The E & R amendments on LB 346 are adopted. Now are there some amendments, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator DeCamp now moves to amend the bill and the amendments are found on page 1045 of the Legislative Journal.

PRESIDENT: The Chair recognizes Senator DeCamp.

SENATOR DeCAMP: It does the following. It clarifies that inquiries relating to central filing may be accepted. Apparently there was confusion on that particular point but those individuals currently filing security interest can receive proof of filing by providing a postage paid envelope. In other words, they pay for it, put the postage on themselves and send it in and then they can mail them back the information; transfers current filings to the Public Service Commission upon the operative date of this act for consistency in filing accuracy in one location and, of course, the Secretary of State requested this as you know, and we went over that before. The purpose of the amendments is to further clarify the intent and allow for efficient handling upon the operative date of the act. This has to do with that central filing thing. Currently
