LB 346, 773A, 304

PRESIDENT: Motion carries and LB 346 is advanced to E & R for engrossment. We will next take up LB 773A.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Koch would like to have 773A laid over.

PRESIDENT: All right. It is an unanimous consent request, any objections? All right, 773A is passed over or laid over. LB 304 is next.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 304, there are E & R amendments.

PRESIDENT: The Chair recognizes Senator Wesely.

SENATOR WESELY: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, I move the E & R amendments to LB 304.

PRESIDENT: All right, the motion is to adopt the E & R amendments to LB 304. Is there any discussion? All those in favor of adopting the E & R amendments to LB 304 signify by saying aye, opposed nay. The E & R amendments on LB 304 are adopted. Are there any amendments?

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Koch now moves to amend the bill and the amendments are on page 939 of the Legislative Journal.

PRESIDENT: The Chair recognizes Senator Koch.

SENATOR KOCH: Mr. President and members of the body, when we were talking about LB 304 a couple of weeks ago we were discussing the position of alien as it relates to tuition fees at the postsecondary educational units, the university and state colleges. At that time there was some concern here about the residency requirement, and as I committed myself to you that day and said we would come back with an amendment and what this amendment does is it says that after two years of residency the Board of Regents can consider with proper documentation an alien to enter the postsecondary educational system on a resident basis. This is what the amendment is about. It requires a two year residency in the State of Nebraska prior to the time that these individuals can be considered for normal tuition fees. I'd ask for adoption of the amendment.

PRESIDENT: The Chair recognizes Senator Kahle.
