CLERK: Senator Fowler voting aye. Senator Fitzgerald voting aye. Senator Vickers voting aye.

SPEAKER MARVEL: We are looking for Senator Pirsch, Senator Chambers, Senator Stoney, Senator Keyes.

CLERK: Senator Stoney voting aye. Senator Reutzel voting aye.

SPEAKER MARVEL: We are voting on the advancement of 986 to E & R for engrossment.

CLERK: Senator Simon voting aye.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Record the vote.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 9 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to advance.
