

Now for me to take this off it is going to cost the state about \$1,200. The reason it is going to cost \$1,200 is because the Appropriations Committee is going to have to come in with a bill to do the same thing, and it cost about \$1,200 to process a bill. If that is the way they want it, that is the way these people are thinking that I am trying to pull shenanigan on them, I would much prefer to withdraw the bill. I didn't want it in the first place, I did it for the Motor Vehicle Department. I will withdraw the amendment. Go ahead and read the bill. Unless there is an objection.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Hearing no objection, so ordered. Now the Clerk will read 693 on Final Reading. Senator Warner your light is on.

SENATOR WARNER: Could I ask a question of the Chair?

SPEAKER MARVEL: Yes, sir.

SENATOR WARNER: I don't know if there is another bill in which this issue can be addressed or not, in your opinion if the . . .if a bill is introduced, I assume that we can assume that it would be possible to put that on special order so that the issue . . .because this is one issue that we have to address, one way or the other, either with money or with legislation.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Are you suggesting that 693. . . .

SENATOR WARNER: No, it can go. I don't care about that. I just want to make sure that we have a vehicle to resolve the question. I guess what I am saying Mr. President, is I will assume that the bill we have to introduce will be handled.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay.

SENATOR WARNER: Because it has to be. Thank you.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Clerk will read 693 on Final Reading.

CLERK: Read LB 693.

SPEAKER: All provisions of law having been complied with, the question is, shall the bill pass? All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Record the vote.

CLERK: 41 ayes, 0 nays, 8 excused and not voting. The vote appears on page 1154 of the Legislative Journal.
