

SPEAKER MARVEL: The bill is declared passed on Final Reading. The Clerk will now read on Final Reading LB 94.

ASSISTANT CLERK: Read LB 94.

SPEAKER MARVEL: All provisions of law having been complied with, the question is, shall the bill pass with the emergency clause attached. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. LB 94 on Final Reading. Record the vote.
