SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is carried, the bill is returned. Now Senator Warner, you want to adopt the amendment. The motion is the adoption of the Warner amendment as found on page 1062. All those in favor of adopting the amendment vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? The Clerk will record the vote.

CLERK: 32 ayes, 0 nays on the motion to adopt the amendment.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The amendment is adopted. Senator Lamb, do you want to move the bill back to E & R for Engrossment.

SENATOR LAMB: I so move Mr. Chairman.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Motion is to advance the bill to E & R for Engrossment. All those in favor of that motion vote aye, opposed vote no. All those in favor say aye, opposed no. Motion carried. Are we through with Final Reading now?

CLERK: Yes sir.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Warner, do you have a motion that you would like to make in regard to 693? 683? You have a bill there.

SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President, I was going to ask to . . . introduction of a bill which would have taken the place of the amendment that Senator Clark withdrew, to extend the license plates, but we haven't got it all signed yet. So, if I can pass over for a little bit.

SPEAKER MARVEL: All right, we have item number six and there is a reconsideration motion. Do you want to read the motion?

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Newell moves to reconsider the body's action of Final Reading of LB 817.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Chair recognizes Senator Newell.

SENATOR NEWELL: Mr. President, members of the body, LB 817 is a retirement bill which was for the University and basically that retirement bill failed on Final Reading by a very close vote. Some of us had problems with the bill, I myself voted against it simply because it did not have any ceiling at all and that it would be purely a process or product of whatever the Appropriations Committee allowed the University to put into retirement. Now I talked to the University prior to the bill's dying on Final Reading and suggested that an 8% ceiling would be a reasonable way to deal with this issue. After the bill failed the University
