

SPEAKER MARVEL: All right, the Legislature will be at ease for a moment. The Clerk is going to try and pull them together. Don't go to far but you can be at ease. The Legislature will come to order.

CLERK: Mr. President, technically Senator Newell would want to withdraw his amendment found on page 1086 and substitute this alternative amendment.

SENATOR NEWELL: So move.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Unanimous consent request to withdraw your amendment. Withdraw your amendment or withdraw the motion? Withdraw the amendment. Okay, all right, so ordered.

CLERK: Senator, would it be helpful for me to read the amendment?

SENATOR NEWELL: It might be.

CLERK: Mr. President, the amendment would read as follows: Read amendment as it appears on page 1157 of the Legislative Journal.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion before the House now is to return the bill for this specific amendment which the Clerk has just read. So the first motion is to return the bill. All those in favor of returning the bill for the specific amendment vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Record.

CLERK: 26 ayes, no nays, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Motion carried. Now the motion is to adopt the amendment as read by the Clerk. All those in favor of that motion vote aye. Opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Record the vote.

CLERK: 28 ayes, 1 nay on the motion to adopt the amendment, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is carried. The amendment is adopted. Now we re-refer the bill to E & R for Engrossment. Do you so move, Senator Newell?

SENATOR NEWELL: I do.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, the motion is to advance the bill to E & R for Engrossment. All those in favor vote aye, those opposed vote no. Excuse me, you had your light on is that what it was for, Senator Murphy? Okay, Senator Murphy, your
