SPEAKER MARVEL: The question has been called for. Do I see five hands? Okay. The question before the House is, shall debate cease? All those in favor of that motion vote aye, opposed no. Record.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 4 nays to cease debate, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, debate has ceased. The Chair recognizes Senator Newell. Do you want to close on your motion?

SENATOR NEWELL: Very briefly, I think that on a....I have already talked. No, I will waive closing. Thank you.

SPEAKER MARVEL: You are going to waive closing. Senator Venditte.

SENATOR VENDITTE: Mr. Chairman, just a point of information, how many Senators are absent today. That would help me better decide how I am going to vote on this issue. I don't know that there has been a confirmed report given to the members as to the number of people absent.

SPEAKER MARVEL: One, two, three, four, five, five are absent.

SENATOR VENDITTE: There are just five members absent?

SPEAKER MARVEL: Yes.

SENATOR VENDITTE: Thank you, Mr. Speaker.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion before the House is to bracket 619 until March 18th and the rules indicate that this takes a majority of those voting. All in favor of the motion to bracket vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? Okay, record the vote.

CLERK: 20 ayes, 15 nays on the motion to bracket.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Motion carried. Bill is bracketed until the 18th of March. The Clerk will read on Final Reading LB 793.

CLERK: (Read LB 793 on Final Reading.)

SPEAKER MARVEL: All provisions of law having been complied with....Senator Keyes, this is your bill. All provisions of law having been complied with, the question is, shall the bill pass? All those in favor vote aye, those opposed
