Your committee on Revenue whose Chairman is Senator Carsten to whom was referred LB 691 instructs me to report the same back to the Legislature with the recommendation it be advanced to General File; and 882 General File with amendments. (Signed) Senator Carsten, Chairman.

SPEAKER MARVEL PRESIDING

SPEAKER MARVEL: General File, LB 863A.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 863A, title read.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Beutler.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Mr. Speaker, members of the Legislature, this A bill relates to the bill which separates the Power Review Board from the Department of Water Resources. It was brought to my attention by Senator Warner that for technical reasons it should have an A bill with it. The A bill does not increase spending in any sense. The Power Review Board is and has been a cash fund and will continue to be so and the level of its expenditures will not increase by virtue of this A bill but because we are separating it from the Department of Water Resources, it is necessary for technical reasons to have an A bill to set up a separate fund for the Power Review Board. So at Senator Warner's suggestion, the A bill is being brought along to catch up with 863 which is on Final Reading. Thank you.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is the advancement of 863A to E & R for review. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Voting on the A bill. We have a whole series of bills here. We do need your cooperation so that you can vote on the ones you are for. Have you all voted? Record the vote.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays on the motion to advance 863A, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The next bill is 423.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 423 was introduced by Senator Glenn Goodrich. Title read. The bill was read on January 17 of last year. It was referred to Miscellaneous Subjects for public hearing. The bill was advanced to General File. Mr. President, I do have amendments from Senator Goodrich. I understand he wishes to withdraw those.

SENATOR GOODRICH: Yes, I do wish to withdraw the amendment.
