LB 423, 739, 918, 990

SENATOR WESELY: I call for the question.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The question has been called for. Do I see five hands? I do. All those in favor of ceasing debate vote aye, opposed vote no. The motion before the House is to cease debate. Shall debate cease? Record.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays to cease debate, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, debate is ceased. The Chair recognizes Senator Goodrich to close on his bill.

SENATOR GOODRICH: Okay, are we ready? SPEAKER MARVEL: I would like to make an agreement with you. If we have a Call of the House, let's keep the House under Call and get out of here on time. Okay. The question is, shall the House go under Call? All those in favor of that motion vote aye, opposed no. Record.

CLERK: 14 ayes, 0 nays to go under Call.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The House is under Call. All legislators please take their seats. Record your presence. Encourage unauthorized personnel to leave the floor.

CLERK: Mr. President, while we are waiting, your committee on Public Health and Welfare whose Chairman is Senator Cullan to whom we referred LB 990 instructs me to report the same back to the Legislature with the recommendation it be advanced to General File with amendments. Signed by Senator Cullan.
