SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Koch.

SENATOR KOCH: Mr. Speaker, in the interest of time, there is another bill that is scheduled for March 25 which deals with the same subject, 722, and I would hope that Senator Fitzgerald would reconsider his motion to lay over till next Tuesday. I would suggest that we lay over to the 25th and we discuss these two bills together since they both deal with the same subject matter and I think that would help us all to make a decision. I would suggest that we do lay it over to the 25th if Senator Fitzgerald would concede to that.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, we need to set it up. Senator Warner. It would be my contention, but I would like to have your input, in answer to Senator Koch that 361 and 722 would come up at the same time. Do you object to this?

SENATOR WARNER: No.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay. Senator Koch.

SENATOR KOCH: I am suggesting that both of them would be treated at the same time because they both deal with the same subject matter basically.

SPEAKER MARVEL: You have got the bill bracketed, is that right, till Tuesday.

SENATOR KOCH: I am asking Senator Fitzgerald to concede to the suggestion that we lay it over to the 25th rather than Tuesday. Would you do that, Senator Fitzgerald?

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Koch, the Chair will set the two bills.
