LB 485, 853

I think we should not adopt the Newell amendment without my amendment. I want to repeat again, it does not in any way affect the use of the polygraph for other purposes but for law enforcement hiring it does. I think it is a reasonable request and I think it is reasonable also to ask that those individuals who are charged with the protection of our life and liberty and our property submit to a higher degree of examination than if you are applying for a job as a tractor driver or an airplane pilot with Schmit.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, the motion is the adoption of the Schmit amendment to LB 485. Is that right, Mr. Clerk? Okay, the Schmit amendment to the Newell amendment. All those in favor vote aye, opposed no. Voting on the Schmit amendment to the Newell amendment. Have you all voted? Senator Schmit, are you there? Okay, record the vote.

CLERK: 18 ayes, 9 nays on the motion to adopt the Schmit amendment to the Newell amendment.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The Schmit amendment is adopted.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Johnson moves to amend the Newell amendment by striking....

SPEAKER MARVEL: How many more motions do we have? I would like to get some Select File motions by voice vote before we adjourn.

CLERK: I have the Johnson amendment to the Newell amendment. That is it and then the Newell amendment would have to be voted on.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Johnson and Senator Newell, do you object if we lay this over to Monday now? Okay, if there is no objection, so ordered. Senator Wesely.

SENATOR WESELY: Mr. Speaker, I move the E & R amendments to LB 853.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is the adoption of the amendments to 853. All those in favor of that motion say aye, opposed no. Motion is carried. The E & R amendments are adopted. Senator Wesely.

SENATOR WESELY: Mr. Speaker, I move that LB 853 be advanced to E & R for engrossment.
