LB 605, 726, 780, 789, 789A

PRESIDENT: Motion carries. The House is under Call. The Sergeant at Arms will see that all members return to the chamber. All legislators return to their desks. All unauthorized personnel will leave the floor. The House is under Call. All legislators will register their presence please.

SENATOR HABERMAN: Mr. Speaker, I will take call in votes. I will take call in votes, Mr. Speaker.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Kahle and Senator Murphy voting aye.

SPEAKER MARVEL PRESIDING

SPEAKER MARVEL: The Call is raised. Announce the vote.

CLERK: All right, Mr. President. 26 ayes, 8 nays. Senator Venditte requested a record vote. (Read record vote found on page 1232 of the Legislative Journal.) 26 ayes, 8 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to advance the bill.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is carried. The bill is advanced. Do you have anything to read in?

CLERK: If I may very quickly, Mr. President, Senator Lewis would like to remind the Legislature, the Executive Board that the introduction for legislative resolutions proposing interim studies is this coming Friday. All the interim study resolutions should be submitted prior... before Friday.

Your committee on retirement whose chairman is Senator Fowler to whom is referred LB 726 instructs me to report the same back to the Legislature with the recommendation it be advanced to General File.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, are we ready to take up 741? First, 605 is advanced, then 789.

CLERK: Mr. President, 789, Senator Warner has motions... amendments both on 789 and 789A and he has been excused until he arrives.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Any objections? If not, 789 will lay over. 780.

CLERK: Mr. President, there is a motion by Senator Murphy to indefinitely postpone 780. That would lay the bill over.
