SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is carried. The bill is advanced. Do you have anything to read in?

CLERK: Yes, sir, I do, if I may. Mr. President, Senator Warner would like print amendments to LB 789 and 789A. (See page 1234 of the Journal.)
