of the book I see. Could you tell us just exactly what you are trying to do?

SENATOR WESELY: Okay, this basically would allow us to use the present system which we converted with the 1974 law that was passed to take the situation where we now stretch out registration of vehicles over the full year. To help a business or a family with a large number of vehicles from having to every month practically, come in and have to register certain parts or certain numbers of their vehicles with the county treasurer. It just would simplify the process for them and, in fact, simplify the process for county treasurers across the state if in these large fleets of vehicles they could pick out a month, say September 1st, that would be for their fiscal year more beneficial. They can come in and for their twenty or ten or five vehicles come in and register and pay the taxes at that time instead of having over the course of the whole year having to pay and register their vehicles.

SENATOR KAHLE: Haven't we been able to do that before?

SENATOR WESELY: No, evidently not. I think, in talking to some members of the Legislature that the feeling was that that was what we already had but evidently that is not the case and that is why we want to change it.

SENATOR KAHLE: Well that is what my county does with me if my license all come due the same month but that is the way I suppose it was started but if I trade vehicles and change the license, why they make it possible for it to come due the same time as the original did.

SENATOR WESELY: They already do that? Is that right?

SENATOR KAHLE: Yes.

SENATOR WESELY: Well, that is not the case evidently in some parts of the state because that is...we found.

SENATOR KAHLE: One of the questions I had then, the title of LB 717 has to do with disabled persons. There is no part of that in this amendment. Is there?

SENATOR WESELY: No.

SENATOR KAHLE: Okay, thank you.
