radar then we should also put the pressure on the citizens of our state who use the fuzzbusters to get by with the law, and if we find any of these in the possession of an automobile and the patrol officer finds this in your possession, then you are subject to arrest. There is a present law in the state of Oklahoma on this very issue and it is working. I understand that Senator Chambers might say that this will not work, but it is working in the State of Oklahoma and the State of Iowa is now considering such a law, and it is before their House at the present time. So I encourage you to adopt this amendment.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Kremer. Do you wish...Senator Marsh, do you wish to speak to the Sieck amendment?

SENATOR MARSH: Yes, thank you, Mr. Speaker. Senator Sieck, I have some questions in my mind that I am wondering what this does. How widely used is it in our state now?

SENATOR SIECK: It is quite widely used by the trucking industries. Most of the trucks do have them on at the present time, and a lot of automobiles have them on.

SENATOR MARSH: Have you contacted the State Patrol so that you are knowledgeable about how they would feel regarding this amendment?

SENATOR SIECK: Yes, I have, and of course I have a....

SENATOR MARSH: Would you feel free to tell us?

SENATOR SIECK: Yes, I have a son that is a highway patrolman, and he was the one that encouraged me to present this amendment, because he feels that they are taken advantage of. At the present time there is a way to get by with these fuzzbusters, that is, the patrol....if he has his machine shut off, then the individual with the fuzzbuster cannot detect the radar machine. But as soon as he shuts it on they detect it and he said he can see those people just slam on the brakes and stop, and he feels this is wrong.

SENATOR MARSH: Would it be necessary for a vehicle to be stopped before you could ascertain whether there was a "fuzzbuster" in the vehicle?

SENATOR SIECK: Yes, it would be. The amendment says that. You have to stop it and see it on his presence. That is right.
