SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is the adoption of the Pirsch amendment to LB 822. All those in favor vote aye, opposed no. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? Senator Pirsch.

SENATOR PIRSCH: I would like to have a Call of the House, please.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The question before the House is, shall the House go under Call? All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Record the vote.

CLERK: 14 ayes, 1 nay to go under Call, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The House is under Call. All legislators please take your seats. Record your presence. Record your presence. Nine absent. Senator Cope. Senator Maresh. Senator Goodrich. Senator Vickers. Senator Cullan. Senator Kelly. Senator Labedz. Goodrich, Cope, Landis, Schmit, and Burrows. The Chair is authorized to take in....the Clerk is authorized to take in call-in votes.

CLERK: Senator Murphy voting aye. Senator Beutler voting aye. Senator Landis, you had voted aye, Senator. Senator Kelly voting aye. Senator Reutzel voting...continuing to voting no. Senator Cullan voting aye. Senator Vickers voting no. Senator Merz voting yes. Senator Burrows voting no.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Goodrich, will you record your presence, please? Okay, we are absent Senator Schmit. Ray, do you want to call Senator Schmit? Do you want to call the roll? Senator Goodrich.

CLERK: Senator Goodrich voting aye. Senator Fitzgerald voting aye.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, record.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 11 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to adopt the amendment.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, the motion is adopted....the amendment is adopted. Now the motion is the adoption of the amendment....or the bill as amended.
