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the other things they had heard and read about it, because those other things were removed and had a coldness that statistics always tend to have. It happens to other people. But if we can say here today that the attitude and philosophy of the Legislature and its policy is that because the World Herald said it you have got to punish a few innocent people and that will improve the system, I have to wonder what the purpose of the system is. Are the small to be sacrificed for the mighty, and as for me making a mockery of the speed laws as this donkey that signed the letter to Senator Venditte wrote, I don't have any points against my license at all. I don't have any points at all against my license. Now it is my understanding....Senator Venditte, could I ask you a question, since you read that nice comment about me into the record, and I appreciate it...just so they talk about me. I hope you spelled my name right. You have a brother who is in law enforcement, don't you?

SENATOR VENDITTE: Yes.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Have you asked him about radar or this bill? Have you discussed it with him?

SENATOR VENDITTE: What does that have to do with the bill, Senator Chambers? Or...yes, in fact, we have discussed it on several occasions, but I...I fail to see...

SENATOR CHAMBERS: What was his attitude about it? Because you give us his view on other things related to law enforcement.

SENATOR VENDITTE: Well, I don't know that I have expressed his view on other related....on other matters relative to law enforcement, Senator Chambers, but....

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Well, how about on this one? What did he say?

SENATOR VENDITTE: Well, to be perfectly honest with you, Senator Chambers, and other members of the Legislature, you know, certainly he has some concerns about radar and I think he probably feels as many of us who have been stopped, and I have been one who have been stopped on the Interstate for speeding. We become very irritated....very irritable that we have been stopped and if given a warning ticket you are not as irritated, but I guess there are some of those in the law enforcement profession, Senator Chambers, who have some reservations as to the accuracy of this

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
