adoption of the amendment.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is the adoption of the amendment to 485A. All those in favor of that motion to change the date from 1979 to 1980 vote aye, opposed vote no. We are voting on the amendment to 485A. Have you all voted? Record.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays on adoption of Senator Newell's amendment.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is carried. The amendment is adopted. Now, Senator Newell, do you want to move the bill?

SENATOR NEWELL: Yes, I move the advancement.

SPEAKER MARVEL: All those in favor of advancing 485A to E & R for Review vote aye, opposed vote no. This is the A bill, 485A. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? Record.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 5 nays on the motion to advance the bill, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is carried. The bill is advanced. 533.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 533 was introduced by the Retirement Systems Committee. (Read title to LB 533.) The bill was read on January on 17. It was referred to Retirement. The bill was advanced to General File. I have committee amendments by Senator Fowler's Retirement Committee. I'm sorry, yes, okay, I'm sorry. There was an amendment by Senator Fowler to the committee amendments that was adopted...the committee amendments were adopted on January 17 of this year. I now have an amendment. The first amendment is by Senator Goodrich. It reads as follows: (Read the Goodrich amendment to LB 533 as found on page 1244 of the Legislative Journal.)

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Fowler, do you want to discuss a little about the bill and then we will go to the amendment?

SENATOR FOWLER: Yes, I appreciate that, Mr. Speaker. It might clarify where we are at with the bill after the committee amendments. LB 533 does two things essentially with regards to judges' retirement. I am having handed out an explanation of this. First of all, there are two
