LB 308, 619, 622, 680

PRESIDENT: Senator Simon, the Chair is going to suggest that we finish Final Reading and then have the bill drafter come up and check it with you and then you can go ahead and reconsider at that time. We will not have lost anything by doing it that way. Would that be all right with you? All right. We will proceed with Final Reading and then you can either bring the bill back, reconsider it, do what ever you want at that time but why don't you have the bill drafter check what would be necessary to carry out the action of the Legislature. We will proceed then with the Final Reading, Mr. Clerk, of LB 619.

CLERK: (Read LB 619 on Final Reading.)

PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relating to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 619 pass. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Record the vote.

CLERK: (Read record vote found on page 1253 of the Legislative Journal.) 27 ayes, 20 nays, 1 excused and not voting and 1 present and not voting, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: LB 619 passes. The Clerk will now read on Final Reading, LB 622.

CLERK: (Read LB 622 on Final Reading.)

PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relating to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 622 pass. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record the vote.

CLERK: (Read record vote found on page 1254 of the Legislative Journal.) 47 ayes, 0 nays, 2 excused and not voting, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: LB 622 passes and, Mr. Clerk, you will read on Final Reading, the last bill for today's Final Reading, LB 680.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Schmit moves to return LB 680 to Select File for a specific amendment, that amendment being to add the emergency clause.

PRESIDENT: The Chair recognizes Senator Schmit.

SENATOR SCHMIT: Mr. President, I would like to ask the body to move the bill back to add the emergency clause. This was a part of the other amendment which failed and I would like
