the major department stores have this legislation available not so much that they can charge that, let's say, a, b, or c customer a certain amount, increased amount, but so that they can get financing from banks themselves to make credit available and the banks aren't going to in many cases, I assure you, I can verify this for you in individual instances that I am not going to go into on the floor, major department stores, they aren't going to go ahead until this issue is resolved. Additionally every time I went in and allowed somebody to offer one of these amendments on the floor, I either said there is problems in it and it turned out the problems were disastrous and they had to pull them off which caused some delays or the amendments didn't do anything. They said, this is one of the examples. This morning my good friend, Senator Simon, was all concerned that the bill drafter had made an error or whoever. It was his own amendment that struck his amendment. So I really think if it is a problem we can attach this language on any one of a number of bills that are floating or coming through, if it is a problem. I think I can guarantee it is not a problem. I urge you to let the bill go to the Governor and get it signed and get this usury thing kind of cleared up.
