SENATOR MURPHY: Thank you.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Haberman, your light was on, do you wish to be recognized? Okay, the motion is to advance the bill. All those in favor of advancing 768 to E & R for review vote aye, opposed vote no. Voting on the advancement of 768 to E & R for review. Have you all voted? Record.

CLERK: 25 ayes, no nays on the motion to advance the bill, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is carried the bill is advanced. The next bill is LB 995.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 995 is introduced by the Appropriations Committee (read LB 995). The bill was first read on March 11th, it was referred directly to General File, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Warner.

SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President, I move LB 995 be advanced to E & R Initial. You have had passed out to you a summary of 995 which indicates the actual deficiency amounts that are changed in the bill or proposed in the bill which for reference purposes might be easier to go through than the bill itself. I should indicate that in addition to what is on the summary sheet are also adjustments and personal services limitations for a variety of agencies reflecting reclassifications or similar adjustments to the personal service limitations during the current year. Included also is a reflection of part of the salary policy which I will cover last that the committee is recommending for this year. One other thing that I should mention, Section one doesn't change the dollars but it does authorize leasing of Majors Hall at Peru in connection with the facility that was constructed down there or authorized and is constructed, authorized a couple of years ago and is now constructed and the use of funds already on hand can be used to lease that building in connection with the field house that was constructed. To give you a quick rundown of the deficiencies that are in the bill. The other adjustment is work load increase in collection agency.
