The office of Governor and Lieutenant Governor in, at their request, adjusted by committee policies, the Secretary of State the adjustment here reflecting committee policy, there was a letter also approved by the Governor, a request from the Secretary of State to begin to computerize their corporate records and documents, those of you who have been in the corporate records section in the Secretary of States office know that they have many, many files piled up very, very high along the walls, this is to begin to get those computerized so that they can reduce that use of space as well as more... and greater convenience. In addition there is a provision for lease of storage space for state records of \$19,826, that is records management that was in the tower but was moved out of the Capitol and the appropriation is written either for a lease or renovation of other state owned buildings that are currently not being used and in all probability the money will be used for renovation rather than for leasing of space. The State Auditors strictly the application of the committee policy, the Attorney General's office applying to policies, we did reduce or eliminate the Medicaid fraud unit and the general fund support for that unit. There were considerable additional federal requirements that were being imposed in terms of the numbers of people that had to be utilized by the Attorney General if we were to qualify for the federal funds the Attorney General and the committee recommends that that be eliminated because compliance to federal standards would be expensive and probably not justified. They are still doing some of this work with contractual money with the Department of Welfare however, but does not require additional state funding for that. The State Treasurer's office is essentially a continuation budget, one additional accounting clerk, Number II, at \$8,000 general fund money and then there is \$22,429 for additional full time auditor-investigator and clerk for the unclaimed property division. The Public Service Commission is at an operating budget with the exception of approval of one additional grain inspector related to the fact that there is a great deal more grain in storage across the state and because of their legal statutory requirements to inspect this grain one additional person is required. The final agency, the Board of Pardons and parole which merely has a continuation budget adjusted by committee policies. I move the bill be advanced.
