LB 999, 1000

There is additional funding for the full twelve month period for the HPER Building, its operating cost is \$200,000 in start up money for the downtown educational center that is funded through UNO. There is additional funds put into the College of Administration and the mathematical computer science recognizing work load increases in those areas. There is also a special general fund appropriation, should be a one time appropriation, to initiate the William Brennan Labor Study Institute which will be a part of the downtown educational service unit. Finally the Med Center, there is a variety of funds that are being picked up of lost federal funds. Some of these are capitation grants or other federal grants, well that reflects a percentage increase for the university, it results in no additional increase for operating funds for the medical center. In addition there is \$350,000 for the College of Dentistry reflecting a number of recommendations in order for that college to maintain its accreditation standards. The full request was for a half a million, the committee recommendation was only at the \$350,000 level. The other, well that is all that was in the bill. I move the bill be advanced.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is the advancement of the bill to E & R Review. All those in favor vote aye, those opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Record the vote, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 2 nays, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion carried, the bill is advanced. The next bill.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 1000 was introduced by the Appropriations Committee. (Read title). The bill was first read on March 11th and was referred directly to General File, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Warner.

SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President, I move that LB 1000 be advanced. This is a reaffirmation of existing appropriations for capital construction. There are no new projects, merely the reaffirmation of those currently under way. The only thing that might be of some significance, and again no change in dollar amounts, but the Lincoln Maximum Security facility is being built ahead of a schedule and there is a million and a half moved up one year from what was originally projected, reflecting the fact that that construction has proceeded at a rate faster than what was expected.
