bad bill. We are, essentially....the amendments essentially will remove from 535 those sections which have become controversial. I agree wholeheartedly with Senator Nichol when he suggests that he has a problem with section 17. I do too. And this is one of the reasons I became interested in this particular bill. We are essentially again returning the bill to its basic form. I would ask the body to return the bill to strike the sections as have been suggested and then let the bill sit, if necessary. I also have no problem with the amendment to make this effective date January 1, 1981. Thank you.

PRESIDENT: The question then is the return of LB 535 for the amendments explained through this long debate. All those in favor of the return vote aye. Opposed nay. I remind everyone we are on Final Reading as far as your presence in the room is concerned. So every member should be at his or her desk. Have you all voted? Record the vote.

CLERK: 28 ayes, 10 nays on the motion to return the bill, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The motion carries. The bill is returned. As the Chair remarked before, this will be placed on Select File by the Speaker. It will be placed on the agenda the way he wants it on the agenda and when. So we will now proceed with Final Reading, Mr. Clerk. Proceed....you may read some matters in while we are getting everyone back. Will the Sergeant at Arms please see to it that all members are back at their desks since we are still on Final Reading.
