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of hours now are probably glad to support that limitation as long as they can tell them how to....what to teach during that number of hours. That wasn't my intention at all. I don't think we should tell the attorneys what they have to be taught. I simply was trying to put a limit on the numbers of hours that was required for the county attorneys of the State of Nebraska. I would oppose Senator Reutzel's amendment.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Reutzel, do you want to close on your amendment?

SENATOR REUTZEL: Certainly. Mr. Speaker and members of the body, with regard to Senator George's remarks, I was at the Chairman's meeting this morning. I don't know if Senator George was, but we discussed moving bills. I would like to move these things just as rapidly as anyone else, but I think they should have thorough discussion. We have a serious amendment up here that was to limit hours, and all we are saying is because of the duties that we have statutorily imposed upon county attorneys and one of those duties is to act as county coroner...so all we are saying is that there should be some training. I'll tell you one thing, they don't....whatever law school they go to, I don't know of any law school that provides any hours in anatomy or forensic pathology, yet we are called upon... we are calling upon those people to make those death determinations. That is a very big part of their job. I think it is a serious amendment, just as serious as Senator Vickers' amendment to it. Now if we are concerned about cost, this is one way to achieve some standards at a very minimal cost. I move the adoption of the amendment.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is the adoption of the Reutzel amendment to the Vickers amendment. All those in favor of the Reutzel amendment vote aye, opposed vote no. Senator Reutzel.

SENATOR REUTZEL: I will ask for a Call of the House and a roll call.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, the question before the House is, shall the House go under Call? All those in favor of placing the House under Call vote aye, opposed vote no. Record the vote.

CLERK: 9 ayes, 2 nays, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The House is under Call. All legislators
