whose chairman is Senator Newell to whom is referred LB 927 instructs me to report the same back to the Legislature with the recommendation it be advanced to General File and 620 indefinitely postponed and those are signed by Senator Newell as Chairman.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Now the way we are going to handle the activities...Senator Nichol, would you like to adjourn us until nine o'clock tomorrow morning?

SENATOR NICHOL: Mr. Chairman, I move that we adjourn until nine o'clock tomorrow morning.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Koch.

SENATOR KOCH: Mr. Speaker, we have spent considerable time with 627 and I know we have former members of this body here to be honored. I would hope that this body would, if there are some amendments pending, it would withdraw those and I will accept those and that we advance 627 and if we want to amend it further we will try it on Select File. I know Senator Newell has an amendment and I have an amendment to his amendment.

SPEAKER MARVEL: There are three amendments I think.

SENATOR KOCH: And if those gentlemen would be willing to withdraw those and speak to them on Select File I would like the privilege of the body to allow us to advance this to E & R initial.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Who has the amendments?

SENATOR KOCH: Otherwise, I understand you are going to lay it over until next week.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Who has the amendments?

CLERK: The first amendment is by Senator DeCamp. The next amendment is by Senator Newell, Mr. President.

SENATOR NEWELL: Mr. President, I need to ask Senator Koch if he would accept the 7% access thing. I cannot vote to advance it and I would not want to vote on this issue unless that would be accepted with the introducer's agreement on Select File.

SENATOR KOCH: Senator Newell, I will allow you an opportunity for that amendment on Select File. You know that I have told you in private discussion, if you can get it on with 25 votes, I will accept that.
