LB 304, 346, 440, 662

Mr. President.

SENATOR CLARK: All we are doing is wasting time. The legislators shall be in their seats on Final Reading.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Are you ready to go, Pat? The Clerk will read LB 304 on Final Reading.

CLERK: Final Reading of LB 304.

CLERK: Record vote read. (See page 1377, Legislative Journal.) 27 ayes, 11 nays, 9 excused and not voting, 2 present and not voting, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The bill is declared passed on Final Reading. There is a motion on the next bill.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Murphy as introducer asks unanimous consent to lay over LB 346.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Any objection? If not, so ordered. Go to the next bill, LB 440.

ASSISTANT CLERK: Final Reading of LB 440.

SPEAKER MARVEL: All provisions of law having been complied with, the question is, shall the bill pass? Those in favor vote aye, opposed no. Have you all voted? Clerk, record the vote.

ASSISTANT CLERK: Record vote read. (See page 1378, Legislative Journal.) 37 ayes, 0 nays, 6 excused and not voting, 6 present and not voting, Mr. President.
