SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion before the House is the striking of the Haberman amendment as previously adopted. Is there any discussion? All those in favor of that motion vote aye, opposed vote no. CLERK: 25 ayes, 5 nays on adoption of the Senator Haberman's motion.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is carried. The amendment is stricken. The motion now is to readvance the bill. Senator Kelly, did you make that motion? Senator Clark. All those in favor of readvancing the bill say aye, opposed no. Motion is carried. The bill is readvanced. Do we have any other complicated measures to bring up?

CLERK: Yes, sir. Mr. President, can I read some things in?

SPEAKER MARVEL: You can read some things in and then we are going to go back to Final Reading.

CLERK: Very quickly, Mr. President. An Attorney General's opinion addressed to Senator DeCamp on LB 831 will be inserted in the Journal.

Your committee on Enrollment and Review respectfully reports they have carefully examined 627 and recommend it be placed on Select File.

Your committee on Public Works whose Chairman is Senator Kremer instructs me...to whom we referred LB 611 reports the same to General File with amendments.
