CLERK: Mr. President, if I may real quickly, Senator Murphy would like to print amendments to LB 689. That is all I have.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Yes, we are ready for LB 789.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 789, I have no E & R amendments to the bill. However, there is an amendment by Senator Vickers to the bill and I understand he wishes to withdraw it. Is that true, Senator? Okay. Senator Vickers wishes to withdraw his amendment, Mr. President. Mr. President, Senator Warner now has an amendment to the bill. I understand he wishes to withdraw. Senator Warner, do you wish to withdraw your amendment to 789? Okay. Mr. President, I have nothing on the bill.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: (Mike off) 789 be advanced.

SPEAKER MARVEL: All those in favor of advancement of the bill say aye, opposed no. Motion carried. The bill is advanced. Do you want to move the A bill.

CLERK: Senator Warner, you have an amendment on the A bill. Do you want to withdraw that, too? Okay, thank you. Okay, Senator.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. Chairman, I move that LB 789A be advanced.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Any further discussion? All those in favor of that motion say aye, opposed no. Motion carried. The bill is advanced. 592.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 592, there are no E & R amendments. Senator Warner has an amendment to the bill. 592, Senator, your motion is to strike Section 2 of the bill.

SENATOR WARNER: What is that, 592?

CLERK: Yes, sir.
