to the State Recreation Road Fund for purposes of funding these roads in addition to the regular State Highway Fund. By taking Section 1 out, there is no longer access to that recreation road fund.

SENATOR REUTZEL: So their resources which are committed for five years in advance are not going to be depleted any further?

SENATOR HOAGLAND: No, it won't touch that fund at all.

SENATOR REUTZEL: Is this the section that Senator Haberman's amendment which we are on now will put back in?

SENATOR HOAGLAND: It will reinstate it. Senator Haberman's amendment will reinstate that.

SENATOR REUTZEL: Now we are getting down to...all right. Well, I apologize to the members, I was not cognizant of the technical aspects of the bill. I assure you we will be but I have had a brief conversation with Dale Bree from Game and Parks Department and I don't know that they are aware that that section has been struck but I think there is some apprehension on their part and I would like some more time in order to get some information back on this. I don't know that I can support the advancement of the bill at this point but it is a very complex bill and I would like to sit down with your staff and go over it and try to work out some of the problems that we have but I would think though that the Haberman motion then which is reinstating what you have struck in Section 1 then I would be opposed to.

SENATOR CLARK: Before we have the next speaker, under the South balcony, Ruth Meyer, Register of Deeds, Lexington, Nebraska, District 39 from Barnett. Will you stand up and be recognized?
