ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read record vote as found on page 1459 of the Legislative Journal.) The vote is 45 ayes, 0 nays, 3 excused and not voting, 1 present and not voting, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, the bill is declared passed with emergency clause attached. We are going to pass over 853 and come back to it after we have finished the last three bills. So the Clerk will now read on Final Reading LB 855.
