All those in favor of the Warner amendments to LB 995 vote aye, opposed vote no. Record the vote.

CLERK: 28 ayes, 0 nays on adoption of the Appropriation Committee amendments, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is carried and the amendments are adopted. Are there any other amendments to 995?

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Kelly had an amendment but wished to withdraw that. Yes, okay. Senator Kelly wants to withdraw his, Mr. President. Senator Lewis has an amendment, but Senator Lewis is excused, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Warner. Senator Warner, can you come down a minute?

SENATOR WARNER: Is this the withdrawal of Senator Lewis' amendment? I think he wants to withdraw it. He indicated that to me. I don't think he....

SPEAKER MARVEL: I think we need to set a policy in regard to amendments to the Appropriations bill when people are gone. Do you....

SENATOR WARNER: In view of the time of the session, Mr. President, and since no one is precluded from offering amendments even after it is any time up to Final Reading, I would think it would expedite things if anyone is absent amendments are passed over and they have to do it whenever they can. In fact, that is the way it ought to be on every bill.
