

which is what the committee intended to do but was left out of the original draft, and this is necessary so there is adequate appropriation with the reappropriation plus new appropriation for the required federal match. The third amendment is, there was a computation error in computing of some of the salaries in the Department of Education. It is an additional \$17,900, but it merely reflects a correction in the computation of the salaries for the agency. The fourth amendment is a transfer of funds only...a reduction actually in general fund money in replacement of cash funds in corrections and it is between the adult meal services and community services program, and what it does reflect is the fact that there is increased fee for food for employees and because of that increased fee that employees will pay the general fund is reduced and transferred to the other program, and the final appropriation reflects the fact that the Governor has transferred water planning money from the Department of Natural Resource Commission over to the Department of Environmental Control, and what the amendment does is reflects the transfer of those funds and the employees to the Department of Environmental Control instead of where they currently are, which is in the Natural Resource Commission. No additional funds, but it does reflect the transfer of those federal funds.

Department of Environmental Control that is done...28 planning money is designated by the Governor as to what agency is to be expended and the Governor did transfer the responsibility for that to the Department of Environmental Control for water planning purposes, and that it was not by action of
