LB 995, 998, 741

CLERK: 13 ayes, 2 nays to go under Call, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, the House is under Call. All legislators please return to your seats and record your presence. Unauthorized personnel please leave the floor. Senator Powers, Senator Koch, Senator Schmit, Senator Merz, Senator Haberman, Senator Simon, Senator Nichol, Senator Kelly. Senator Nichol, do you want to record your presence? Senator Dworak is missing. Read the motion, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Hefner moves to amend the bill. I'd better not paraphrase.

SPEAKER MARVEL: \$50.00 a month for food. Is that right? Okay. Call the roll.

CLERK: (Read roll call vote found on page 1469 of the Legislative Journal.) 19 ayes, 25 nays, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion lost. The Call is raised. Mr. Clerk, are you through? Do you have anything to read in?

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Burrows would like to print amendments to LB 995, Senator Landis to LB 741, Senator Johnson to LB 741, Senator Fowler to LB 741. (See page 1470 of the Legislative Journal.)

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, Senator Kelly, will you recess us until 1:30?

SENATOR KELLY: Yes, Mr. Speaker, I would like to recess us until 1:30 and make a historical comment regarding Senator Murphy and his actions here this morning. It never occurred to me that he would be one that would be out to break the budget, but he voted yes on this budget-breaking amendment, Mr. Speaker, and I want that in the record. I move we adjourn until 1:30.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Recess until 1:30, Senator Kelly.

SENATOR KELLY: Recess until 1:30.

SPEAKER MARVEL: All those in favor of recessing until 1:30 say aye. Opposed no. The motion carried. We are recessed.
