

Because, that in fact is what ends up happening. They are saying that you don't have enough intelligence, we are the only ones that know what is right. You don't understand the budget like we do because you are.....I don't know if it is you are not smart enough, or haven't taken enough time to look at it. I don't think that is the case. I think that Senator Schmit brings up some good arguments, Senator Beutler does too and I think that perhaps in a specific area, and I hope that this isn't blasphemy, but I think perhaps in the specific area that maybe Senator Schmit may know almost as much about a particular area as somebody on the budget committee. I think that that is possible. I think that it is just possible that on a particular area that maybe Senator Simon or maybe Senator Kahle or Senator Beutler has just as much knowledge in that particular area as a member of the Appropriations Committee. So, I rise to support, I realize that is heresy, Senator Chambers, I rise to support the amendment, and I do say that I think we need to take a look at the appropriation bills very carefully and it seems to me that there are legitimate amendments which have been offered and which should be adopted.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Lamb.

SENATOR LAMB: If there are any other lights on I call for the question, Mr. Chairman.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The question has been called for. Do I see five hands? I do. All those in favor of ceasing debate vote aye, opposed vote no. The question before the House is shall the debate cease. Record the vote.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 5 nays, Mr. President, to cease debate.
