SPEAKER MARVEL: Pardon? Your light was on. I recognized you. Do you wish to speak to the motion to readvance?

SENATOR HABERMAN: Can I move the question or do I have to speak to the motion to advance?

SPEAKER MARVEL: No, you can move the question.

SENATOR HABERMAN: I move the question.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, the question has been called for. Do I see five hands? Okay, the motion before the House is shall debate cease. All those in favor vote aye, opposed no. The motion is to cease debate. Do you wish to cease debate on this particular issue? Record.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 10 nays to cease debate, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, the motion is to readvance the bill. Senator Haberman, do you have any comments to make in closing on the motion to readvance?

SENATOR HABERMAN: The only comments I would make, Mr. President, is I did not have some material available when this was brought back so I won't go into depth but I will give one case, one case of where this was needed and that was in Dakota City and the Iowa Beef Packers. People left the strike line area and were milling about and fighting and shooting and arguing and they used the dispersal statute then. They needed it then and they might need it again in the future so there was one case where they needed it and they still need this bill, as amended, they still need the bill. I will vote to advance it with the amendment but if we poke any more holes in it, then it won't be worth anything. Thank you, Mr. President. That is my close. I move to advance the bill.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Simon, for what purpose do you arise? Senator Haberman was closing.

SENATOR SIMON: Well I rise for a point of information. The bill as it is now amended wouldn't cover what Senator Haberman suggested anyway.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is not debatable. He was closing.

SENATOR SIMON: But I am saying, he gave an incorrect statement. He said that the...

SPEAKER MARVEL: I'm sorry we can't debate once it is closed. The motion now is to readvance the bill. All
