I am for their amusement and entertainment. I wonder now who has the popcorn concession when these young students come and want me to talk to them. Tit for tat, measure for measure, if the rule of the game is that we treat each other as though we are not human beings, the rule can be applied across the board. Some people can apply it with the finesse of a meat cleaver and others can do it with the finesse of a scalpel but remember there will come times when other people's rights, other people's dignity will be at stake and I know for a certainty that there will be a different reaction by this Legislature. I am just wondering what athletes will think when I have my meeting with them and I will be able to explain to them what happened over here in this Legislature today. They thought that they were really something in this state and that white people really loved them and they said just wait until the test comes and we will see how wrong the black students are. But you have resolved the entire argument. I wonder how many on this floor would vote to put some money in the budget to create a scholarship program for minority students since we are trading and dealing in money. I wonder how many would do that. Then we don't have to talk about morality anymore. We don't have to talk about right and wrong and I hope really that I don't hear those words on the floor of the Legislature again but I know that I will because they are only words but I will not vote to advance that bill. I will not vote for its passage and to me every vote for 999, every vote against the amendment that I offered is to be interpreted by me as an endorsement, Senator Marsh, of South Africa and what it stands for, of the blood money accepted by the University through its bagmen or bagpersons, the University Foundation, and I will act accordingly and we will see if the crushing victory that you got today should be a cause for celebration throughout
