SENATOR KOCH: It is construction currently underway? There is no. . . .

SENATOR WARNER: LB 1000 had that.

SENATOR KOCH: That is right, I understand 1000. 1001 now as I understand it is a blue print for capital construction and commitment of this body for that construction in the future.

SENATOR WARNER: Yes.

SENATOR KOCH: Is Senator Schmit here? Since he is the expert on the budget I would like to ask him some questions if he would yield. Senator Warner, you have been under a lot of stress and strain and some rather cheap shots and I'm asking if you would, to take a little time, to go through 1001 and talk about what you consider to be the real priorities of it. I'm sure that the committee, and I have faith in the committee, that what you are addressing here that there is a merit without going into a great deal of debate. But as you look at it and would summarize it, how would you state it succinctly?

SENATOR WARNER: That is difficult for me to do, distinctly. Senator Koch, there are a variety of what can be, I suppose termed as minor renovation type of projects for. . . including for the Nebraska School of the Visually Impaired a variety of buildings at...under the Department of Public Institutions, Lincoln, Norfolk, Hastings, Beatrice, there is a little paving fund that the Nebraska Center for Children and Youth, there is the renovation and the purchase of another facility essentially for status offenders. Under the Department of Welfare there is Appropriation for the Department of Roads which is a variety of maintenance structures, repair structures around the state and there are a great many Game and Parks appropriations, all of these however are out of cash funds with the exception of some minor cabinets and sinks and some, a water well, a little paving around Ak-Sar-Ben Aquarium. There is some initial funds in the Department of Correctional Services, one is for lighting around the Nebraska Center for Women, some planning funds for some renovation of a building there, fire safety projects. There is funds to replace the transmitter at North Platte, Nebraska ETV which is both federal and state funds. The major construction that is included in the bill at the state colleges is the Calvin T. Ryan library at Kearney. Past studies indicate that there are substantial over crowding or lack of adequate library space on the basis of the enrollment at this Institution.
