

There is some funds to do some more thorough subsoil study for the entire Chadron State campus because you know we have had numerous problems there. There is the renovation of the Ag Engineering Building at UNL. There are funds to remodel space at the Med Center to provide hospital dentistry program. There is \$20,000 planning funds for, which is required by statute, for a new laboratory science building at UNO, but only the planning money is subject to whatever future action legislature takes. There is renovation funds for Bessey Hall at UNL, it has been only partially used now for two or three years, waiting to be renovated. There is the purchase of Hattie B. Munroe facility at the Med Center. There is funds to acquire property at the university campus at UNO. The other major project that is included here would be the renovation of the former Elks Building which is now the Heritage Center Museum at a million and a half and then there is \$250,000 authorized which is the continuing part of the renovation of the State Capitol building and essentially that would be the major items. The other large item would be six million dollars appropriation for the LB 309 deferred maintenance building.

SENATOR KOCH: Thank you, Senator Warner, I guess I really wanted to have Senator Schmit here. I appreciate your explanation.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Keyes.

SENATOR KEYES: Yes, I have a question that I would like to have Senator Warner elaborate on. Senator Warner, that \$20,000 for planning at UNO. I presume that is construction planning?

SENATOR WARNER: Pardon?

SENATOR KEYES: Is that construction planning?

SENATOR WARNER: No. Under the statute, Senator Keyes, it has been law for some years now, any major structure by law, the initial appropriation is the planning appropriation which essentially is just to establish justification for a structure. Preliminary justification in terms of additional class space, if it happens to be that kind of a facility or laboratory space, it is to provide the kind of information that the legislature needs in order to justify the total construction of the facility. This does not. . . there are not architectural designs or any of that kind of work that is done, but it is to fully develop the broad guidelines that are needed to provide the legislature the necessary information.....

SENATOR KEYES: But I am led to believe that. . . Senator Warner,
