am I led to believe then that we have \$25,000 worth of planning money at the UNO to try to figure out some building that we will need in the future?

SENATOR WARNER: No. I don't believe that is what I said, Senator Keyes.

SENATOR KEYES: I was kind of gathering that from what you said.

SENATOR WARNER: The planning money is specifically directed for a new laboratory science building, in part it means that there are a number of temporary facilities that are used in part there, it would lead to the elimination of those eventually and if you will look on page 2 of the bill, it spells out specifics of what is required, but it is to complete a program statement which establishes program objectives, facilities, requirements, long range impact of the program statement including such things as the annual operating costs, the analysis of existing facilities in terms of current utilization, anticipated reutilization and necessary renovation as a result, a program statement. It goes on.

SENATOR KEYES: Now, Senator Warner, how much more are we going to put into the Elks Club here in Lincoln? We are talking about closing Peru University, I think that there are probably two campuses, two expenditures that are coming up here that I would like to look at. I am very interested in the Elks Club. How much do we appropriate for it and how much in the future?

SENATOR WARNER: The bill contains \$1,100,000 for '80-'81 and an additional \$400,000 for '81-'82 fiscal year. The total figure a million and a half.

SENATOR KEYES: Will that raise our construction budget?

SENATOR WARNER: Raise it?

SENATOR KEYES: Yes, raise the amount. . . .what I mean is are we getting through constructing some buildings and then planning to construct another and are always constructing... planning to construct another building while we are still constructing the other one. I don't want to get involved in too much money here involving the next legislature.

SENATOR WARNER: Senator Keyes, let me respond to you this way: The committee took the policy, the level of appropriation this year is that no credit level from the total capital construction was last year, that includes reaffirmation. That is buildings currently under construction. Then
